Peace be upon you, God's mercy and His blessings:

I, the Muslim, [REDACTED] / Abu 'Udai, live in a house in [REDACTED] neighborhood. The brothers of the Real Estate [center] said that they demand an official agreement from the wali in order for me to stay in this house and avoid eviction. I lived in this house based on an agreement by the [previous] wali of Mosul, Abul-Layth, may God accept him. I also would like to inform you that I'm originally from Hadithah and I was forced to leave my house by the apostates in 2009, and my house was demolished. Then I moved to Baiji, but the apostates also demolished my house. Knowing that I'm the father of martyr [REDACTED] Abu Mahmud, who was killed in Hit by the Crusader Americans, the father of a wounded and disabled man, [REDACTED] Abu Hajar, who lost his leg during al-Siniyyah battle in Baiji, and the father of the fighter, [REDACTED] Abu Abdullah, the military transporter of wilayat Salahuddin. And for your information, my wounded son is still receiving treatment in Mosul, and therefore, I can't live outside of this blessed wilayah. Also, my wife is suffering from a stroke and needs treatment in the hospital every once in a while. Thus, and after submitting my case, I ask your kindness to look into my case in a merciful way and let me stay in the house I live in or grant me another one in Mosul. Please facilitate my affairs and do the necessary procedures with this regard.

May God reward you the best and guide you to what pleases Him.
